For Reflection and Discussion:

1. Spend some time reading the Christmas story according to Luke 1-2. What kind of reactions were had by Mary, Joseph, the angels, the shepherds, Simeon, Anna, and others to the news and birth of Jesus? What did they say? What did they do?
2. Why was the news so good to them? Is it as good of news now as it was then? Consider the Ephesians study we have been hearing recently, and the truth that only in the completed work of Jesus are we saved and made new. Do we slow down enough to allow the magnitude of the good news of Jesus's birth to sink in? How can we intentionally do so?
3. The news of Jesus's birth often caused the hearer to praise God and proclaim the good news to others. Does the yearly retelling of this news cause similar heartfelt worship and obedience to flow from you?
4. What are some ways that you, your family, and friends can intentionally focus your attention on the good news of Jesus' birth this year so that you may fully experience Christmas together? See the Advent Conspiracy post on The City, and use the four tenants to guide you through your Christmas planning.
